

WINTER FABRIC as demonstrated at the last meeting.

Using the odds and ends of wool you collect after finishing a project.

I use polar fleece as the base fabric.

Make enough of the fabric to complete the project you have in mind.

THIS IS HOW I WAS SHOWN SO NOT THE ONLY WAY !!! Many of you had great ideas to take it further.

Spray the polar fleece with Quilter's basting spray

Lay the wool in any pattern, style, clump you like. Thickness is at your discretion.

(I think boucle and the clumpy wool you can get now would make a fabulous faux astrakhan !!!) A few strands of glitter could be added with the gorgeous threads you can get these days

When you have it the way you like, press it down into the basting spray so it stays in one place.

Cover with soluble stabiliser. I think the fabric ones are better...personal choice, no scientific reason.

With your walking foot on, sew either a grid or a random line of stitches making sure you cross over so the wool is securely fastened under the thread.

Follow the instructions for your soluble stabiliser to remove it.

Place your pattern, cut out and sew Voila!!! Simple
